- What additional context about student experiences can help me better understand these milestone rates?

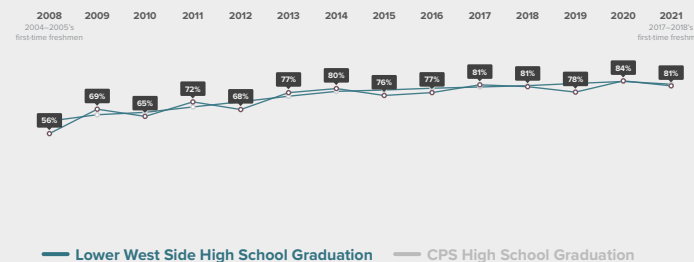

## College Enrollment

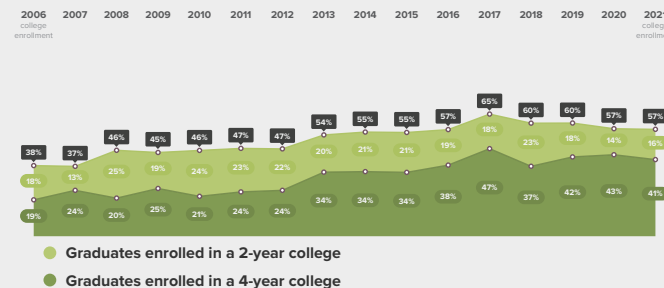


100% of 2021 high school graduates from Lower West Side enrolled in college in fall of 2021.

## College Persistence

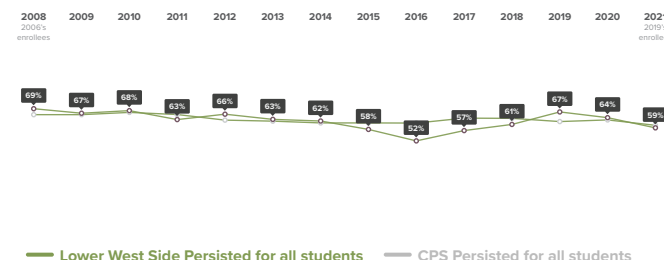


100% of 2019 high school graduates from Lower West Side who enrolled in college in fall of 2019 were continuously enrolled through spring of 2021.
