Freshman OnTrack

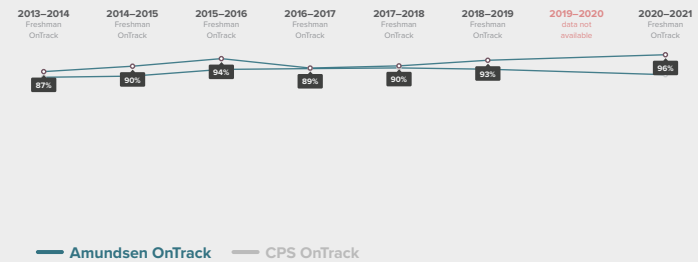


of 2020–2021 first-time freshmen at Amundsen were on-track to graduate from high school in 4 years.

- Failed no more than **1** semester of a core course in their first year of high school

High School Graduation

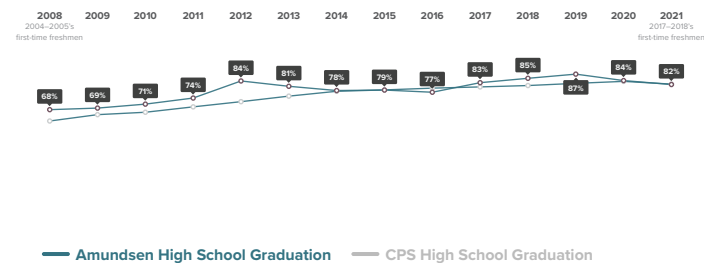


of 2017–2018 first-time freshmen at Amundsen graduated high school by spring of 2021.

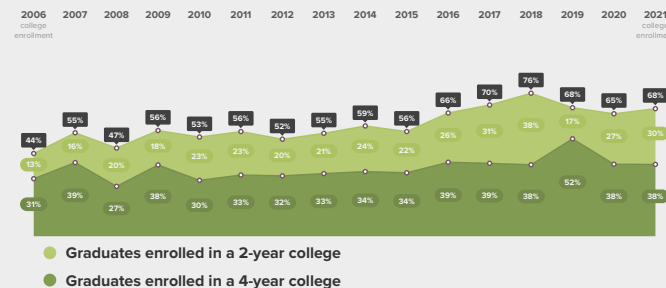

of 2019 high school graduates from Amundsen who enrolled in college in fall of 2019 were continuously enrolled through spring of 2021.

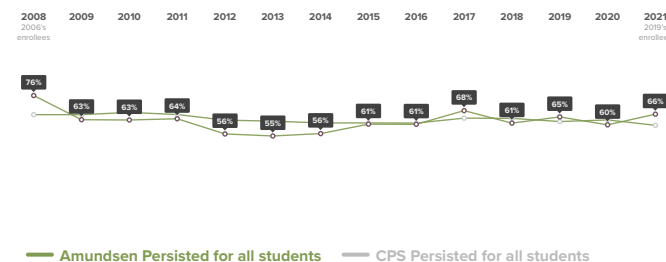
Where are 2019 Amundsen graduates after 4 semesters?

2-year enrollees 2019 Immediate Enrollees from Amundsen
 2% transferred to a 4-year college
56% remained in a 2-year college
42% did not persist

An additional 13% of Amundsen's 2019 high school graduates who immediately enrolled in 2-year college transferred to a 4-year college at semester 5.

4-year enrollees 2019 Immediate Enrollees from Amundsen
 65% remained in a 4-year college
4% transferred to a 2-year college
31% did not persist

of 2015 high school graduates from Amundsen who immediately enrolled in college completed a degree or credential by spring of 2021.

What credentials did 2015 Amundsen graduates complete and how did college completion at Amundsen compare to completion across CPS?

 36% completed bachelor's degree
 17% completed associate degree or certificate
47% did not complete college

College Completion by 2021 2015 Immediate Enrollees from CPS
 38% completed bachelor's degree
 10% completed associate degree or certificate
51% did not complete college
