Freshman OnTrack

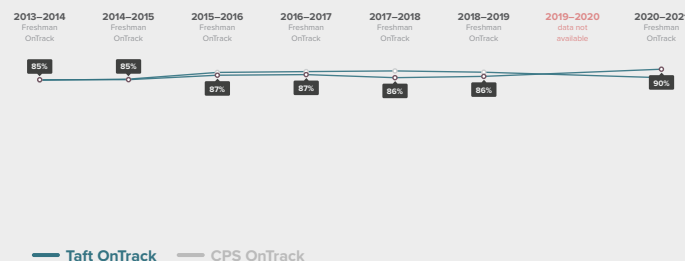


of 2020–2021 first-time freshmen at Taft were on-track to graduate from high school in 4 years.

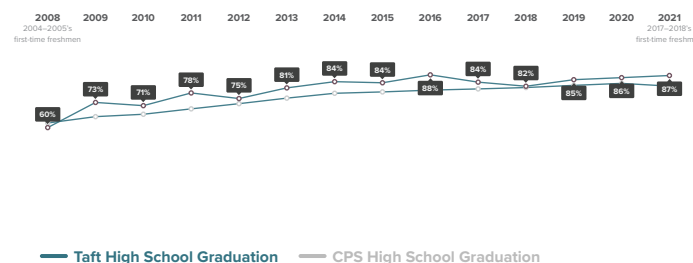

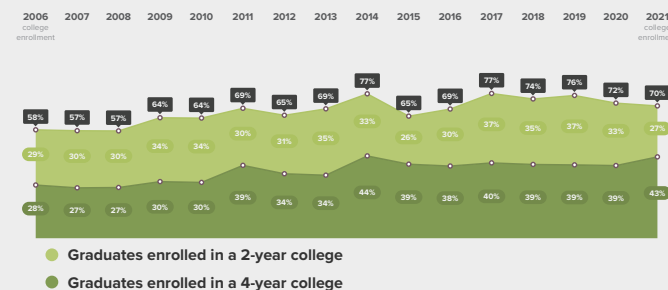

College Persistence



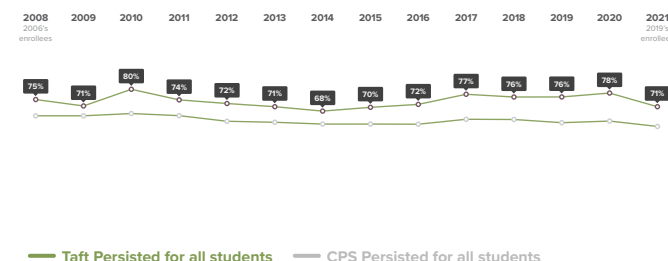
100% of 2019 high school graduates from Taft who enrolled in college in fall of 2019 were continuously enrolled through spring of 2021.
