9th Grade On-Track

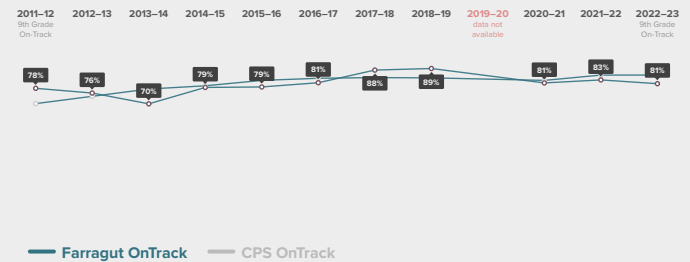

- Failed no more than 1 semester of a core course in their first year of high school

High School Graduation

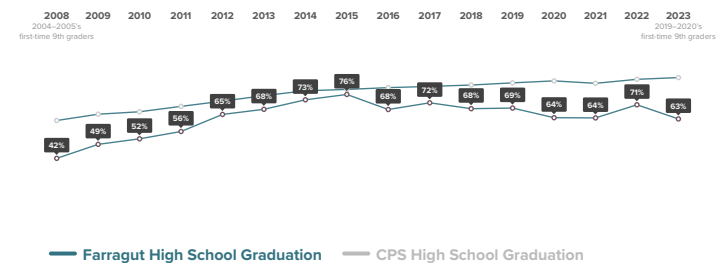

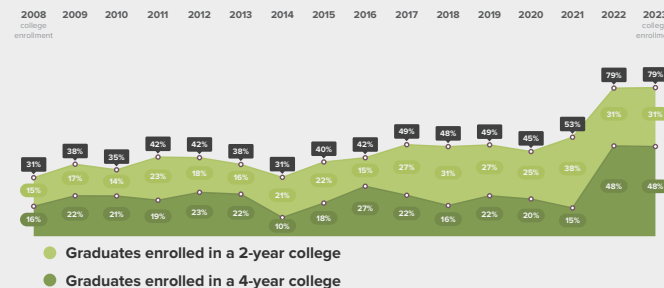

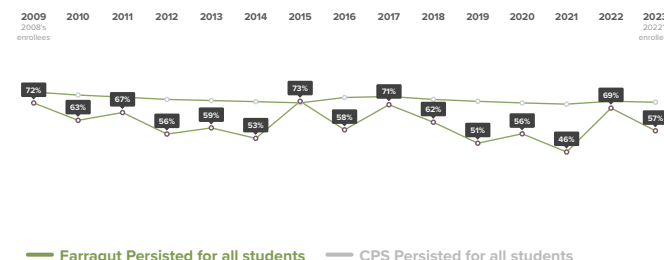
