9th Grade On-Track

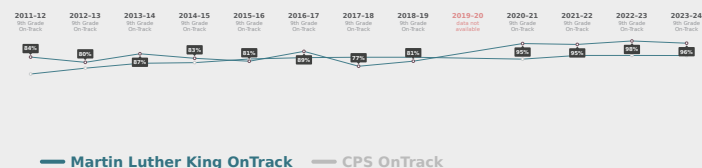
96%

of 2023-2024 first-time 9th graders at Martin Luther King were on-track to graduate from high school in 4 years.

A student is considered on-track to graduate at the end of their ninth-grade year if they earn at least 6.5 total credits by the end of ninth grade, meaning they can fail no more than 1 semester course (including non-core subjects).

Students who are on-track are more likely to graduate high school and enroll in college.

60% graduated with Highly Competitive / Competitive College Access

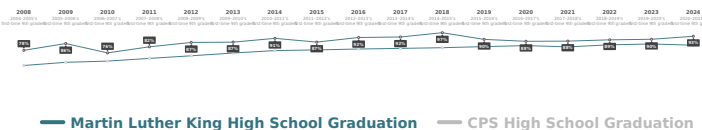
16% graduated with Moderately Competitive College Access

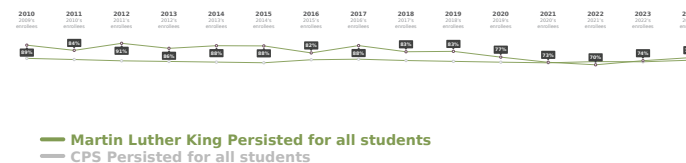
